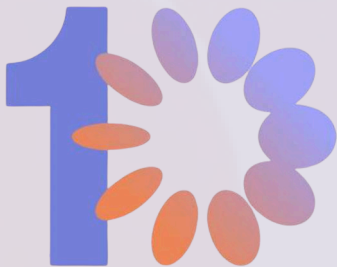
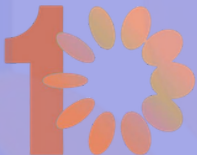




THE KIGALI AMENDMENT

The Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol was adopted in October 2016.



Within 10 years, it has been ratified by more than 170 countries worldwide.



THE KIGALI AMENDMENT



- ✓ **Aims to reduce** HFC consumption and production by more than 80% over the next 30 years.

- ✓ **Aims to avoid** up to 0.5°C of global warming by 2100.



HFCs

do not damage the ozone layer, but they are extremely powerful greenhouse gases widely used in refrigeration and air-conditioning systems.
